Diagnosis Treated Today :

1. Post-traumatic stress disorder, unspecified (F43.10)
2. Other specified anxiety disorders (F41.8)

Purpose of Visit: 90 day PWB CFT - PTSD, anger outburst, other specified anxiety, asylum seeker and grief finding.

Intervention PN: CFT was facilitated with Social Worker (SW - care coordinator), Mental Health Worker (MHW), client and foster father. CFT started with identifying strengths and a mental health strength was shared about client learning grounding coping skills in therapy. Therapist provided updates on client's mental health treatment and talked about how client is showing themes of grief and therapy is now also focusing on processing grief, PTSD symptoms and abreaactions. Therapist coordinated with care coordinator and MHW about continuing to support client in coping with grief with coping tools and the "memory box", therapist will process grief in therapy session and monitor any abreaactions. Therapist learned from SW that client might have an upcoming court date and she will update the team when it is known. Therapist and CFT team talked about any concerns and foster father shared about the hoarding and anger outburst still being a concern even though there has been some improvement. Therapist and team all agreed that focus of treatment and services can be to improve behavioral regulation and behaviors as that is resulting from grief. Therapist learned MHW will also work with foster father and mother on how to support client with behaviors at home through parenting skills.

Intensive Care Coordination PN Plan: Next CFT is scheduled for 5/9/2023. Client and foster family will continue meeting with treatment team. Client will see therapist next seek for session to process trauma and grief.
