Diagnosis Treated Today :

1. Post-traumatic stress disorder, unspecified (F43.11)

Purpose of Visit: Problem addressed today: F43.10 - Client was referred for mental health evaluation for possible post traumatic stress disorder.

Intervention PN: Clinician met with client for a first assessment session. Clinician introduced himself and observed client being slow to warm up, being fidgety, looked tearful and not wanting to explore the room at first. After some time and with gentle encouragement clinician observed client being open to use the sand tray as an activity to further gather information for the assessment. Clinician asked client to show him his family using the sand tray to gather family information. From the sand tray activity clinician gathered that client had lost his mother and client presented a sad manner and slowed down his motor activity (client placed mother figure underground). Client then talked about his trauma of being locked away in a truck and got a truck figure looking at it first, making it "crash" and then threw it out of the tray. Clinician then used a drawing activity to assess behaviors such as anger and learned from the drawing that client will throw things and cry. Clinician used a timer to assess how client transitions from activities and how he responded going back to foster parents, client showed a change in affect and seemed more calm when going back to foster parent. Overall client was receptive to using sand tray and drawing for gathering information, client did show some reactions (throwing truck) when talking about his trauma during immigration.

MHS Assessment PN Plan: Clinician will conduct another assessment session using art to gather assessment information and clients perspective on triggers and flashbacks/intrusive memories.
