*Encounter Smart Template :* Facility: CYS East

*Diagnosis Treated Today :* F43.11 Post traumatic stress disorder - acute.

*Purpose of Visit :* To further assess for frequency and severity of trauma symptoms, current fear of re-occurrence and trauma related guilt in order to formulate treatment recommendations. Went to client's home to do both the child and parent interview and testing measures.

*Intervention :* Conducted interview of client and parent separately utilizing the UCLA Child/Adolescent PTSD Reaction index - for DSM-5. Client was cooperative and answered questions. As he recalled some incidents, his body tightened up, and he appeared stressed. Was able to complete interview and test question items. Client appeared to give adequate effort to respond to evaluators question, and the test is believed to be a valid measure of his current functioning. Evaluator also administered the Parent/Caregiver version of the same measure. Mother was forthcoming with her answers and expressed feeling overwhelmed not know what to do to help both her children. Both versions were scored and indicative of severe trauma and current symptoms occurring frequently.
