Diagnosis Treated Today :

1. Post-traumatic stress disorder, acute (F43.11)

Purpose of Visit : Mother canceled Cal's assessment session scheduled for 3/24/2023 due to obtaining employment for family to be able to pay rent. Since the family has only 1 car and father works evenings while mother works day shift, a telephone assessment was conducted with mother on Monday evening to complete the gathering of history for the assessment. Current problem addressed: F43.11 PTSD - acute. Mother and client were at home in the privacy of their room.

Intervention : Gathered information and history for domains 5 and 6. Discussed with mother how trauma has impacted family life and relationships between sibling, parents and client. Mother indicated that father is distant and working all the time and has difficulty talking to client directly. Family has no support of extended family and no financial support as they are struggling to make enough, even with both parents working. Client feels guilty around sister for not being able to protect her and has been unable to deal with the tension and unspoken issue. Client listened to phone call and only responded when question was directed to him. He gave one word answers. Mother and client did not endorse any S/I or H/I thoughts or attempts recently.

MHS Assessment PN Plan : Therapist will complete domain 7 as information for domains 1-6 have been gathered. Will meet with family possibly by phone if family is unable to come in for the review of the 7 domain assessment and treatment recommendations. Appointment scheduled for 3/31/2023.
