Purpose of Visit: Problem List: F43.11 PTSD - Acute; T74.22XA Child Sexual Abuse - Confirmed; F93.0 Separation Anxiety Disorder.

Intervention PN: The purpose of this initial interview was to process the intake documentation which was completed and signed by SSA social worker who is able to sign as legal guardian at present. The required county forms including informed consent, etc. were completed to initiate service. All intake documentation is filed in client's chart. Provider initially met with Adriana in the waiting room area. She was escorted to the offices by Orangewood cottage staff. She would not separate from the staff as this provider invited client to come into the office. As I motioned and held out my hand to motion for client to join me, she held onto staff tightly refusing to give eye contact to this interviewer. Therapist worked on building rapport to facilitate the transition to separating from staff in order to join therapist. Therapist utilized puppets to engage client in exchange with therapist. Client refused. I then asked cottage staff to walk with me to the office so client could see where we would talk. As we walked together toward the office I focused on the excitement of having client come to my office so, I can show her some of the fun toys I have for us to play with and we can talk. Although Adriana refused to give eye contact to this provider she did walk along with cottage staff to the office and she immediately went over to a corner area of the office and sat down. Therapist asked cottage staff to wait in the waiting room re-assuring client that the staff would be there. Minor, screamed and started to whimper. Therapist reflected to client that she could see client was sad and that she did not want the staff to leave her but, she is safe with the undersigned therapist. Therapist explained to client that today they were just going to talk a little bit about her family and how she came to the US. Therapist began to gather information from client by asking client questions about who are the members of her family. I explained that her social worker told me a little bit about her but, I wanted to see if she could tell me a little more about her family. Client was tearful and said her mama and papa were gone. Mama sent her away. Therapist asked client to draw a picture of the family. Adriana refused and began to tantrum. Therapist reflected client's feelings of sadness and encouraged her to tell therapist why she was sad and crying. Client unable to verbalize. I then asked cottage staff to come in to sit with us as I suggested that I would invite Adriana to come back tomorrow. Adriana took cottage staff's hand as they left the office.

MHS Assessment PN Plan: Provider will continue interview tomorrow. Adriana stopped crying once cottage staff re-entered the office. She did not respond when therapist informed her that they would see each other tomorrow to continue to talk a little more about family. Provider requested cottage staff to escort client back to cottage. Therapist will review and gather information provided by SSA worker in an effort to build rapport and continue assessment of Adriana.
