Diagnosis Treated Today :

1. Post-traumatic stress disorder, acute (F43.11)
2. Major depressive disorder, single episode, unspecified (F32.9)
3. Separation anxiety disorder of childhood (F93.0)
4. Enuresis not due to a substance or known physiological condition (F98.0)
5. Child sexual abuse, confirmed, initial encounter (T74.22XA)
6. Homelessness unspecified (Z59.00)

Purpose of Visit : Meet with client's CEGU team to assist with behavioral concerns in the placement.

Intervention : Team meeting was conducted at CEGU without the client to inform the team regarding client's behaviors and how to address them. Meeting was attended by client's CEGU therapist, CEGU MHW and CEGU psychologist and CEGU Psychiatrist. Discussed client's concerning behaviors including tantrums, fighting, agitation, continued bed-wetting and recent attempt to run away. Team plans to create a safety plan to increase client's engagement in treatment and reduce acting out behaviors. CEGU therapist shared client's openness to sharing about her father's death and missing her mother. Therapist shares that the client has become more open in session; however, this has led to more negative behaviors after session. MHW and therapist plan to work together to create a reward system to introduce it to the client and the cottage staff. CEGU psychiatrist shared that he has started medication to address Enuresis and possible sleep concerns. CEGU psychiatrist also continues to monitor possible concerns that may be expressed by cottage staff (sleep difficulty and not eating enough). The team discussed possible referral for psychological assessment to focus on any additional concerns including attachment and relational issues. CEGU psychologist gathered information to determine if the client is appropriate referral for psychological testing and agreed to conduct psychological evaluation.

Plan : Team to continue collaborating to develop plans for client's success in her placement and reduce negative behaviors. Client to remain at Orangewood and CEGU therapist and CEGU MHW to continue meeting on a weekly basis. CEGU therapist to place a referral for psychological assessment. CEGU psychiatrist to monitor client. CEGU psychologist to begin psychological assessment and testing. Team will meet again in the next 30 days.
