Diagnosis Treated Today :

1. Post-traumatic stress disorder, acute (F43.11)
2. Separation anxiety disorder of childhood (F93.0)
3. Enuresis not due to a substance or known physiological condition (F98.0)
4. Homelessness unspecified (Z59.00)

Purpose of Visit : Primary therapist consulted with MD psychiatrist to discuss case, formulate and development of client's treatment plan based upon client's current presentation of PTSD, separation anxiety disorder, Enuresis, Homelessness.

Intervention : Therapist and MD discussed client's presenting and current symptoms: Recent hospitalization 10 days ago when returned to CEGU after losing foster placement and being separated from cousin due to her uncontrollable crying spells, emotional outbursts, trauma ab reactions from history of sexual molestation, nocturnal enuresis, aggression and unresolved grief. All of these difficulties overwhelmed her foster caregivers. Therapist and MD discussed results of the psychiatrist's medication evaluation if medication was recommended to help stabilize client and prepare her for an eventual return to foster placement with her cousin. MD informed therapist that since the current foster placement was unable to provide the structure need for client, that the social worker was considering an STRTP placement to further stabilize client prior to transitioning her back into foster placement. Therefore, this MD would consult with therapeutic strategies therapist will address in attempting to stabilize client in preparation for transition to the STRTP placement, with the eventual goal of reuniting client with her cousin in foster placement. Therapist and MD discussed client's enuresis and history of sexual molestation. Discussed intervention strategies to address sleep disturbance, aggression, emotional outbursts and sadness. *Plan* : Therapist will finalize Care Plan following today's consultation. The types of services that will be offered (i.e., Individual therapy, ICC, MD, Med Mgmt and strategies to help client cope with symptoms of trauma due to unexpected exposure to danger, molestation, separation from parent/family, loss of other parent (deceased). Therapist to work with client individually to decrease emotional outbursts while at CEGU and to continue to monitor client and consult with MD if symptoms worsen.
