Diagnosis Treated Today :

1. Other conduct disorders (F91.8)
2. Post-traumatic stress disorder, chronic (F43.12)

Purpose of Visit: Cal was referred to CYS East by his probation officer to assess for angry outbursts that led to a physical altercation between a couple and himself. Cal reported that he witnessed a couple having a heated argument. When the boyfriend struck his girlfriend, he intervened and told the boyfriend to stop. The boyfriend got angry and told him to mind his own business and pushed Cal. Cal pushed back and before he realized what happened, they were wrestling on the ground, and Cal eventually beat the boyfriend up badly as the boyfriend had multiple cuts and gashes on his head that eventually resulted in 39 stitches to close up the wound. The girlfriend screamed for the two to stop and eventually called the police and reported that Cal attacked the boyfriend. She did not report the couple's altercation and denied asking or needing his protection.

Intervention PN: Reviewed consents and purpose of assessment. Gathered information and reason for referral from client and probation officer. Explored history and triggers for presenting problem. Also gathered history of previous treatment from CYS East in 2011 for PTSD, acute and family history of immigration trauma. Gathered legal history with probation officer and client. Cal was cooperative although reluctant to consider that past trauma had any connection to his current reactions as he indicated he should be over it by now. P.O. was lost in understanding how Cal could let this happen to him when he had almost finished probation within 2-3 weeks and had too much to lose, and it didn't even involve him.

MHS Assessment PN Plan: Will complete assessment gathering next session and explore several areas of needs as well as continue exploring how past trauma may be causing some trauma abreaactions without client making the connection of past trauma to current perceived danger.
